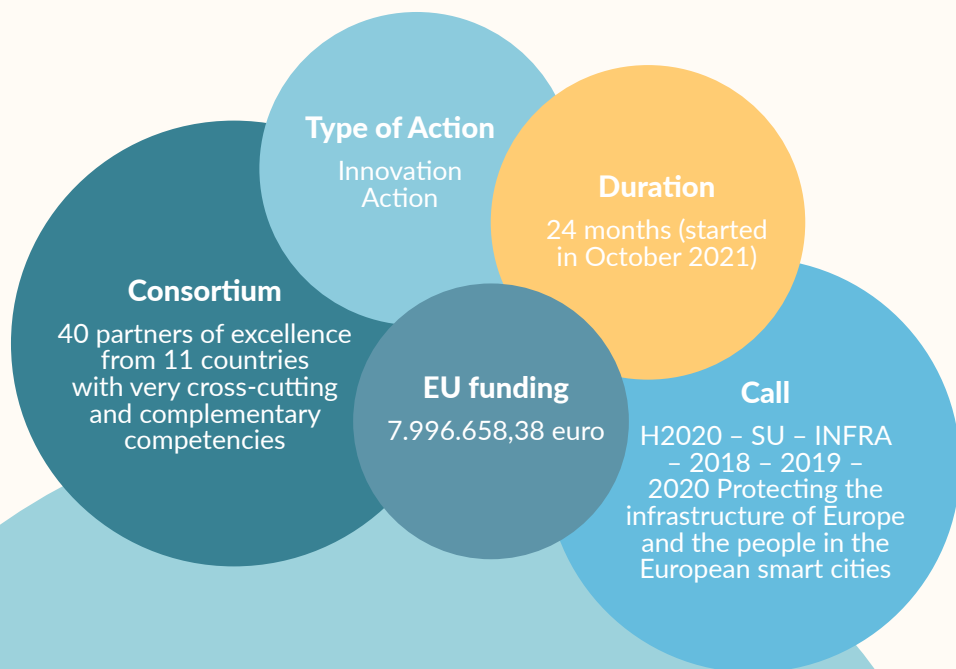

# What's PRECINCT about



## Objectives

PRECINCT aims to connect private and public CI (Critical Infrastructure) stakeholders in a geographical area to a common cyber-physical security management approach which will yield a protected territory for citizens and infrastructures. The ultimate ambition is that PRECINCT can be replicated efficiently and effectively for a safer Europe.

## Expected Impact

The involvement of 11 CIs representing the transport, water, energy and ICT sectors and 2 law enforcement agencies as active project partners, covering different type of CIs (private/public), size and geographical distribution. In 4 Living Labs and 3 Demonstrators more than 20 CIs and first responders, national authorities will participate creating a critical mass for adoption and providing evidence of what is working we, and which components provide clear advantages.
